Water Safety Program

Because we care... Six simple steps to safety!



ALL non-swimmers must be registered at the facility by a parent/guardian prior to or upon entry to the facility.



Parents/guardians and non-swimming children should receive written and verbal site-specific water safety instructions along with "Learn to Swim" information.



Parents/guardians will be advised to SUPERVISE their children and keep them within arm's reach.



Non-swimmers **seven years of age** and under (or less than 48 inches tall) must wear a clearly identifiable **wrist band** and a United States Coast Guard Approved Lifejacket Type III, and remain in designated shallow water areas. They must also be within arm's reach of a parent/guardian (at least 16 years of age) who is in the water with the child.



Non-swimmers **ages eight through twelve** must wear a clearly identifiable **wrist band** and a USCG-Approved Lifejacket Type III, and must be actively supervised by a swimming parent/guardian (at least 16 years of age).



Anyone who wishes to access deep water (greater than five feet deep) must pass the facility swim test or wear a USCG-Approved Lifejacket Type III.
